Concert Etiquette

Audience member responsibilities

- While waiting for the concert to begin, sit quietly. Talking is ok before the concert begins, but not during. Many people think that their whispering will be quiet enough for nobody to hear. That is not true. Everybody can hear it and it is distracting.
- Applaud after each FULL piece has been performed. Some pieces have more than one movement. If you're not sure, watch the conductor. Her arms will usually go down when the piece is over.
- Yelling, screaming, or calling out performer names is never appropriate during concert choir performances.
- If you have a paper concert program or cough drops/candies with wrappers, avoid rattling it during the performance.
- If you must leave, wait for the end of a piece. When returning, wait for the end of a piece.
- Silence all electronic devices.
- Photos are ok; videos are not ok; use discretion with flash photos as they can be distracting.
- Keep small children with you. If they are not able to remain quiet, please bring them to the cafeteria. Children under the age of three are not recommended in this atmosphere.
